

1. The percentages are aggregated across all the University programmes which accept A-Level qualifications within each academic cluster.
2. No GES data is shown as we have yet to graduate our first batch of graduates from this programme.
3. There is only one set of GES figures for the Food Business Management (FBM) programme, with no separation by specialisations.
4. The Graduate Employment Survey (GES) 2024 results were for 3 separate programmes before they were merged (with effect from AY2022 intake):

Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Marine Engineering: 88.9%, \$4,400

Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Naval Architecture: 90.0%, \$4,000

Bachelor of Engineering with Honours in Offshore Engineering: 81.3%, \$4,400

5. The following programmes only had their programme names changed in AY2025:

B (Hons) Accountancy changed to BBus (Hons) Accountancy

B (Hons) Hospitality Business changed to BBus (Hons) Hospitality and Tourism Management

BSc (Hons) Air Transport Management changed to BBus (Hons) Aviation Management

BSc (Hons) Digital Communications and Integrated Media changed to BSc (Hons) Communication & Digital Media

6. The following programmes are new programmes with their first intake in AY2025. Likewise, they do not have any GES data yet.

7. From AY2026, the following subjects will be taken into consideration for UAS computation:

- 3 H2 content-based subjects

- General Paper (GP)

H1 Mother Tongue Language and/or the fourth H1/H2 content-based subject may be considered if it improves the UAS. Students will be required to obtain a pass grade in Project Work to be eligible for admission.

Note: From AY2026, H2 Knowledge & Inquiry (KI) will no longer be considered in lieu of GP. If offered, H2 KI will be considered as a H2 content-based subject.

8. The UAS bands presented above are based on the former 90-point scale.
