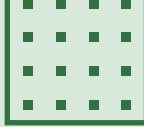

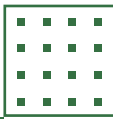

MATRICULATION

All successful applicants who have accepted SIT's offers are required to complete the matriculation process before commencing their studies in SIT. To complete the matriculation exercise please refer to the MATRICULATION GUIDE, which will be sent to you by June 2025.



Important Dates and Deadlines

For the AY2025/2026 intake, the matriculation package will be sent to students via e-mail as per the schedule below:

- Food Business Management – 15 May 2025 onwards
- Allied Health Programmes (HSS) – 15 May 2025 onwards
- All other programmes – 2 June 2025 onwards

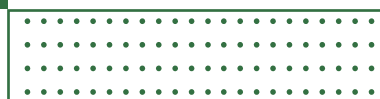
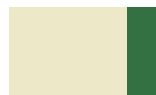
